- 1 Thessalonians 5.17 Never stop praying.

Some see prayer as: 1. Another thing to add. **2.** A ritual. **3.** A good backup should I need help. **4.** The start of a timer for God to answer. **5.** Communion with the Lord; when they pray, they listen, wait on God, and leave the answer in His hands. **6.** Joyful communion with their Savior.

PRAYER:

1. CAN BE LEARNED.

Luke 11.1 Once Jesus was in a certain place <u>praying</u>. As he finished, one of his disciples came to him and said, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples.

- 2. IS MORE THAN A MONOLOGUE CONVERSATION WITH GOD. IT'S ALSO LISTENING. While we speak to God in prayer, it's also wise to listen to God in prayer.

What about the person who aggravates you?

Luke 23.34 *Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they don't know what they are doing."*

Colossians 3.13 Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.

3. IS ASKING GOD SOME QUESTIONS TO DISCOVER WHAT HE WANTS, BUT IT IS ALSO RELINQUISHMENT.

Luke 22.42 Father, if you are willing, please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine.

4. IS A WEAPON TO OVERCOME EVIL.

1 Peter 5.8 Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.

Ephesians 6.10-12 A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. 12 For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places.

Ephesians 6.18 Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be <u>persistent</u> in your prayers for all believers everywhere.

Luke 5.16 But Jesus often withdrew to the wilderness for prayer.

Jeremiah 33.3 (The Message) Call to me and I will answer you. I'll tell you marvelous and wondrous things that you could never figure out on your own.
